

First issue of \$460,000. Bonds were awarded Parkinson & Burr and Jackson & Curtis, August 10, 1904 @ 108.42 they being the highest bidders. Second issue of \$228,000. sold July 6, 1905 to Easterbrook & Co., Boston, @ 107 $\frac{1}{4}$.

AUGUSTA WATER DISTRICT.

The District is incorporated under Chapter 334 of the Private and Special Laws of Maine, approved March 26, 1903.

The following territory and people within the same, namely, Wards one, two, three, four, six, seven and eight in the City of Augusta are constituted a body politic and corporate under the name of Augusta Water District, for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of said district and of the towns of Chelsea, Vassalborough, China and Manchester and such municipalities together with the City of Augusta, with pure water for domestic and municipal purposes.
